## ALS

With no known cure, ALS is a progressive neurodegenerative disease that affects nerve cells and the spinal cord. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs has recognized ALS as a service-connected disease, concluding that people who have served in the military are at greater risk of acquiring and dying from the disease.

HealthBridge's goal is to provide veterans with the highest level of care, occupational therapy and assistive devices such as Dynavox designed to offer a means of reliable communication through voice recognition. The psychological impacts of ALS can be devastating and we recognize the importance of quality care, a comfortable environment and family involvement in the process.
